## RALLY DESCRIPTION

Where are the two most popular places to visit in the Eastern United States? Would you believe, New York City and the Amish Country! Our tour bus drives right through the huge Kreider dairy barn which houses over 1,200 cows, then watch the cows ride the automatic carousel in the state-of-the-art milking parlor before enjoying lunch at the Kreider Dairy Restaurant. We are welcomed into an Amish homestead as guests to enjoy an authentic Amish dinner. We also make stops at an Amish farm, quilt and craft shop and Kitchen Kettle Village.

Day 4 we go to the sweetest place on earth, Hershey, PA. Our guide takes us on a tour of Hershey then visits the Hershey Museum, Hershey Gardens and Hershey Chocolate World complete with free samples. On our return trip to the RV Park we take back roads visiting some very unique and interesting places.
