TOUR DESCRIPTION

Spring Green, Wisconsin (Day 1 - 3)

This tour begins in architecturally beautiful Spring Green, home of Frank Lloyd Wright, long recognized as America's foremost architect. We visit his studio plus Wisconsin's famous #1 attraction, The House on the Rock. You have never - anywhere or at anytime - seen anything remotely like the House On The Rock. We visit the Cedar Grove Cheese Factory and watch them make cheese and then enjoy quality time in "Little Switzerland" (New Glarus) before touring the magnificent natural caverns of the Cave Of The Mounds.

Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin (Day 4 - 8)

The Wisconsin Dells has catapulted in popularity to one of the top vacation spots in the country. We see the stunning beauty of the Dells by water on a guided Upper Dells boat cruise. We take a leisurely tour through Lost Canyon by horse-drawn wagon and on land by rail on a steam-powered train. We even tour by land and water aboard an amphibious WWII Duck.

Within all this excitement we visit a Whooping Crane colony in a natural setting and enjoy a live circus performance under the Big Top. We visit the Hinchley Dairy Farm for an honest to goodness hands-on tour and then spend quality time at the H. H. Bennett Studio and History Center.

We also enjoy a popular live Broadway Musical stage show along with a fabulous dinner.

Oshkosh Fly-in Air Show (Day 9 - 16)

For over 50 years during the last week of July, Wittman Regional Airport in Oshkosh, Wisconsin becomes a magical place where flight enthusiasts and aircraft gather for the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) AirVenture Fly-in. See meticulously cared for antique, classic and home-built airplanes - hundreds of them. Some are rare; some are special only to their owners. Of course, there are plenty of military airplanes to admire, air show performers to marvel at and the latest and greatest new airplanes to ponder. Oshkosh brings together a greater number of aviation enthusiasts than anywhere on earth.

"What do you want to do today?" It's a question that is asked hundreds of times during AirVenture. For seven incredible days we enjoy America's supreme air show as more than 10,000 airplanes from over 80 countries converge on Oshkosh. These airplanes cover the range from 240-pound micro-lights to heavy lift transports and

everything in between. We have access to all these planes and can wander among the rows of airplanes, seeing the new, the unique and the meticulously restored. We can see home-builts, classics, vintage aircraft, warbirds, ultralights, rotorcraft or whatever your favorite is.

An EAA one-year membership is included in your tour package which garners you its benefits both at the air show and after you get back home.

At AeroShell Square, the main display ramp, some of the biggest, rarest and most interesting aircraft are on display. We might see anything from the Spirit of St. Louis to a Stealth fighter.

On the flight line, we can inspect firsthand the craftsmanship and design advancements of home-builts that came from the hands and minds of EAA members.

The AirVenture Forums area is the location where aviation leaders, NASA researchers, FAA personnel and aircraft designers conduct more than 500 forums.

The Exhibit Building has just about everything available in aviation.

The EAA AirVenture Museum includes an impressive collection of more than 200 airplanes, six movie theaters, art and photo galleries, flight simulators, gift shops and two "hands-on" interactive workshops.

Fabulous Air Shows are held every afternoon. They start with showcase flying. Many unique aircraft, from early air racers to historical airplanes, participate. That's followed by the finest air show you will see anywhere. Wing walkers on high-powered bi-planes, WWII airplanes chasing each other in mock dogfights, parachute demos and team aerobatics of two, three and four aircraft. We see the best pilots in the world doing things in airplanes you didn't know were possible. Even the warbirds get into the act doing their signature formation acts.

Evenings are times to visit the Theater in the Woods to enjoy superb aviation programs and entertainment. Typical programs may feature NASA astronauts, top test pilots or world-famous aviation personalities.

No matter what your interest, you find plenty of ways to occupy yourself. And no doubt you also find plenty of reasons to come back next year for more. This air show is a part of our great country you don't want to miss.

Camping at the Air Show in Oshkosh

We stay at Camp Scholler, right on the air show grounds near all the EAA events. We provide 30 amp, 24 hour generated electrical hookups for our exclusive use. Bathroom and shower facilities are nearby. Fresh water for holding tank, dump stations and a portable dumping service are available nearby.
