TOUR DESCRIPTION

This fun filled 34-day Alaska Express is designed for those who have a limited amount of time but want to see and do as much as possible in some of the most beautiful and unspoiled areas on earth. During this tour you observe the real Alaska, covering the most interesting and important parts of "The Land of the Midnight Sun" and her most beautiful Northlands.

No Alaska trip would be complete without visiting the halibut and salmon fishing Capitals of the World in Homer and Seward. Most people catch their limit. You have a chance to bag up to a 300 pound halibut if you choose to go on an optional fishing trip in Homer. Note: We include Homer, Seward, and Juneau on our short trips. If you go to Alaska don't miss out on these spectacular areas.

Included in this tour are the prime areas that you want to see on a trip to Alaska including Dawson Creek, Whitehorse, Dawson City, Fairbanks, Anchorage, Homer, Seward, Palmer, Denali, Skagway and Juneau. Points of interest include: The El Dorado Gold Mine Tour, Top of the World Highway, Mt. McKinley, Lynn Fjord and the scenic Cassiar Highway along with Alaska's breathtaking beauty. A few of the big highlights are watching bears catching fish in the streams at Hyder, hilarious live stage shows, Stern Wheeler "Riverboat Discovery" Cruise, Kenai Fjords Glacier and Wildlife Dinner Cruise, a wildlife bus tour of Denali National Park and boat cruise to Juneau seeing bald eagles, wildlife and whales.
