TOUR DESCRIPTION

Alaska was purchased by the United States from Russia in 1867 and became the 49th state on January 3, 1959. Alaska is the largest state in the union, twice the size of Texas and ranks 49th in population, with Wyoming being the only state with fewer residents.

Alaska has 17 of the 20 highest mountains in the United States, including Mt. McKinley which is the highest peak in North America. There is no other destination with the same combination of accessibility, scenery, wildlife, outdoor activities, facilities or support. A trip to Alaska by RV is bound to be the trip of a lifetime.

Come with Adventure Caravans and enjoy the spectacular scenery, pioneer shows and native customs of the indigenous people. Get a first-hand look at where the Yukon Gold Rush took place and actually get a chance to pan for gold yourself.
