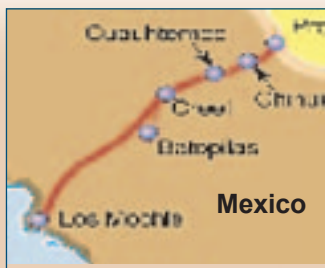

Batopilas and the bottom of the Copper Canyon is definitely the highlight of this trip and one or two days is not enough time to fully enjoy this incredible area so we scheduled four days and three nights accommodations at a beautiful hotel including eight meals along with a welcome to Batopilas dinner and regional entertainment. This along with our full-time licensed local Copper Canyon guide are all part of our Batopilas stay.

We rendezvous in Presidio, Texas where Adventure Caravans Staff greet and invite you to an orientation and get acquainted party.

In Chihuahua, we enjoy a Welcome to Mexico Dinner and private live stage show with Folkloric Dancers. Also included is a city tour where you view Pancho Villa's home, the famous prison, exotic pottery artisans, Government Palace, the Cathedral and many other historical places.

Then on to Tarahumara Indian pine tree country and the logging town of Creel, gateway to the famous Copper Canyon.

Creel boasts a unique mountain village atmosphere and while there we observe, first hand, the lifestyle of the primitive Tarahumara Indians.

To top off this trip, the 17-Day boards a first-class passenger train to El Fuerte on the Chihuahua-Pacifico Railroad experiencing absolutely breath taking views of the Copper Canyon. Upon arriving in El Fuerte we enjoy a two night stay at the first-class Pasado Hidalgo Hotel plus a tour of this quaint little city.
