### TOUR DESCRIPTION

Dinner is included at the Santa Anita Hotel upon our arrival in Los Mochis. Pet care is available at the RV park while we are in the canyon. The next morning, we board a first-class passenger train on the Chihuahua-Pacifico Railroad experiencing absolutely breath taking views of the Copper Canyon. Adventure Caravans gives you an extraordinary adventure in the Copper Canyon, as we are the only company that stays nine days and eight nights experiencing the "Eighth Wonder of the World." We depart the train in Tarahumara Indian pine tree country and the logging town of Creel, gateway to the famous Copper Canyon.
